

## PROJECT: Rehabilitate the Presidio Water Treatment Complex

**LOCATION:** Presidio of San Francisco, San Francisco California

**SIZE:** 12,000 sf, **DATE:** 1993-1995

**ROLE:** Historic architecture consultant and technical design reviewer.

**DESCRIPTION:** This project rehabilitated a historic 1912 water treatment complex to serve as the contemporary water treatment facilities for the 21st century Presidio community. This \$7 million dollar project was competed in 1995. Interventions include, reroofing, hazardous material abatement, seismic rehabilitation of the historic masonry shell and steel structure of the building, introduction of modern water treatment facilities. Historic treatment tanks and pumps are retained in the building to be interpreted to school groups and show the evolution of water treatment from early 20<sup>th</sup> century to late 20th century. At the time of the project Designers estimated this million gallon per day treatment plant would likely be the sole operating plant on the San Francisco peninsula a major seismic event
