**ROLE:** Project manager for construction documents, and construction.

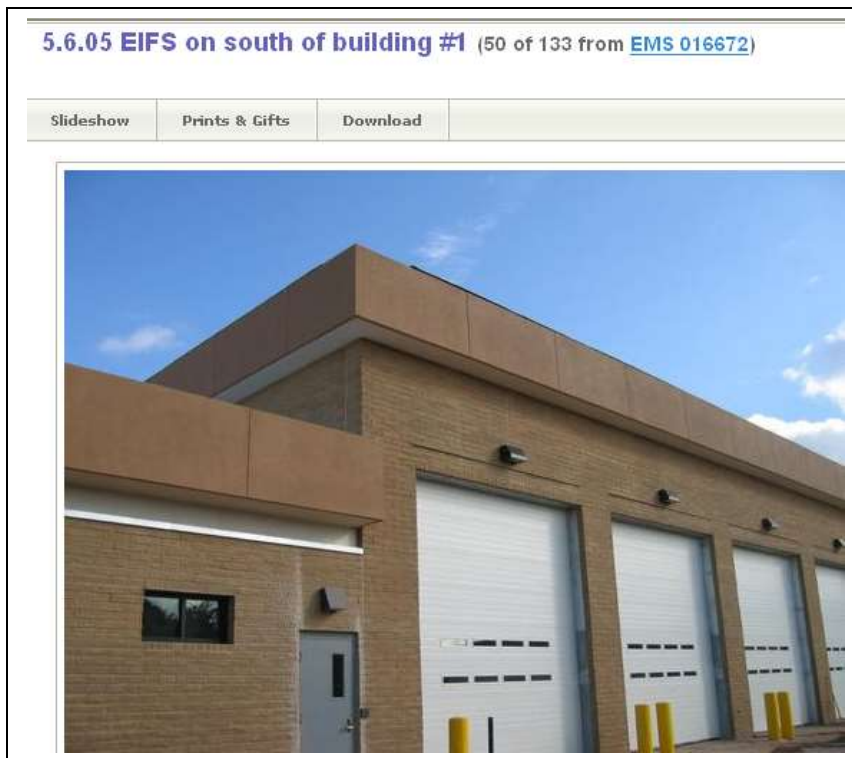
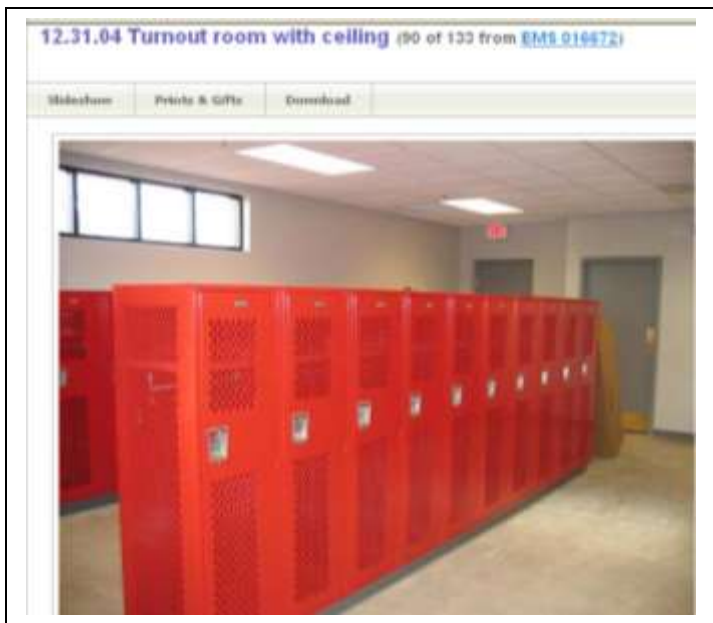
**DESCRIPTION:**

The Emergency Services Facility (EMS) project will construct 11,600 SF of new facilities and remodel 4100 SF of space within the Clinic Building currently occupied by the science center staff.

The facility includes: an apparatus building for ladder truck bays, ambulance parking bays, rescue equipment parking bays, a turnout room, SAR cache, EMS cache, fire equipment storage, and other miscellaneous spaces. It will also provide staff offices, a training/Incident command room, restrooms/showers, a breakroom/kitchen, and other incidental space such as corridors and storage.
